It provides a centralized space to share important announcements, celebrate achievements, and align everyone's goals.

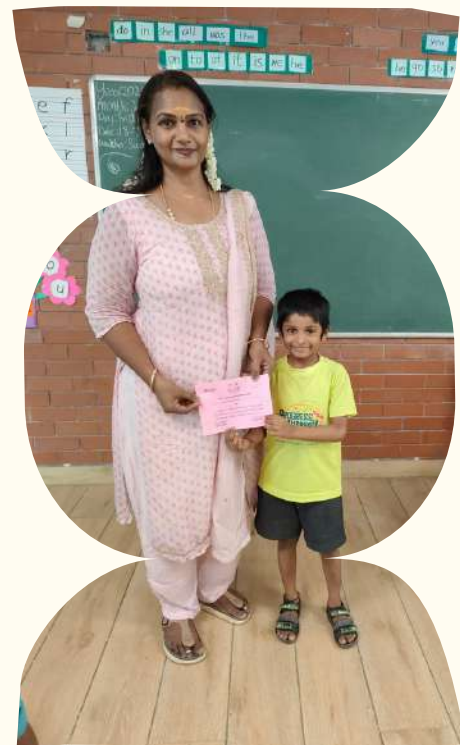


Kudos Card

Tracing Activity

Tracing activities play a vital role in building the muscles, coordination and control needed to hold and guide a pencil.



Tracing helps in understanding the basic stroke patterns which forms the building blocks of letters and numbers.



Repeated tracing builds the small hand and finger muscles needed for a steady pencil grip.



Small, achievable successes in tracing encourage children to attempt writing independently.



This fun hands-on activity helps to lay the groundwork for confident and controlled handwriting in the years ahead.

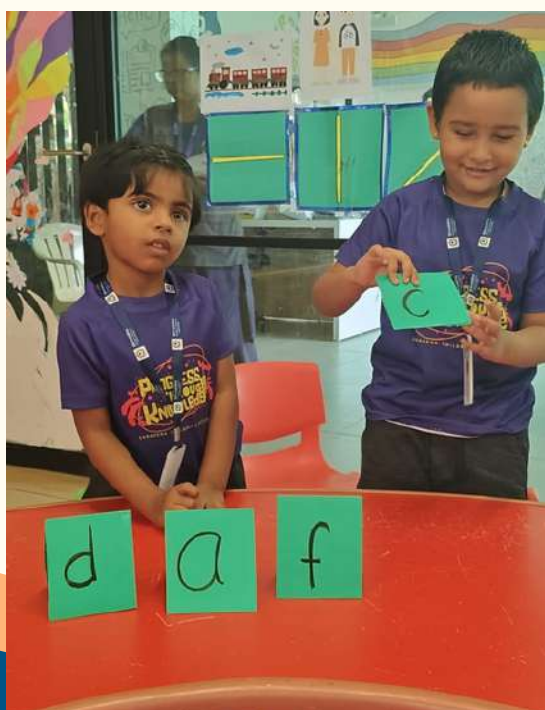
The mystery bag activity strengthens letter - sound recognition and builds confidence in identifying beginning sounds.

Word Building

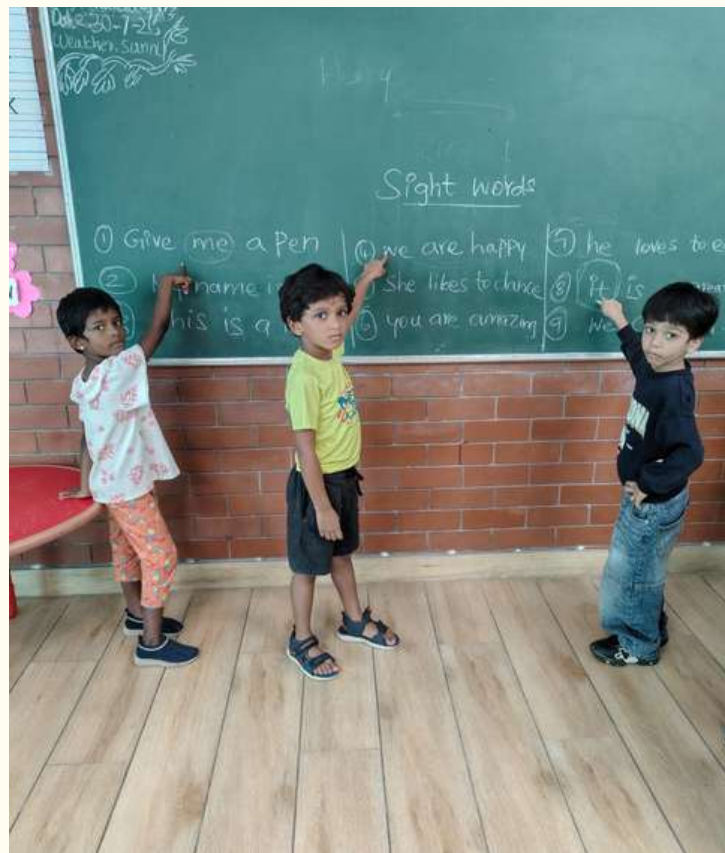
The activity builds phonemic awareness by breaking words into their individual sounds



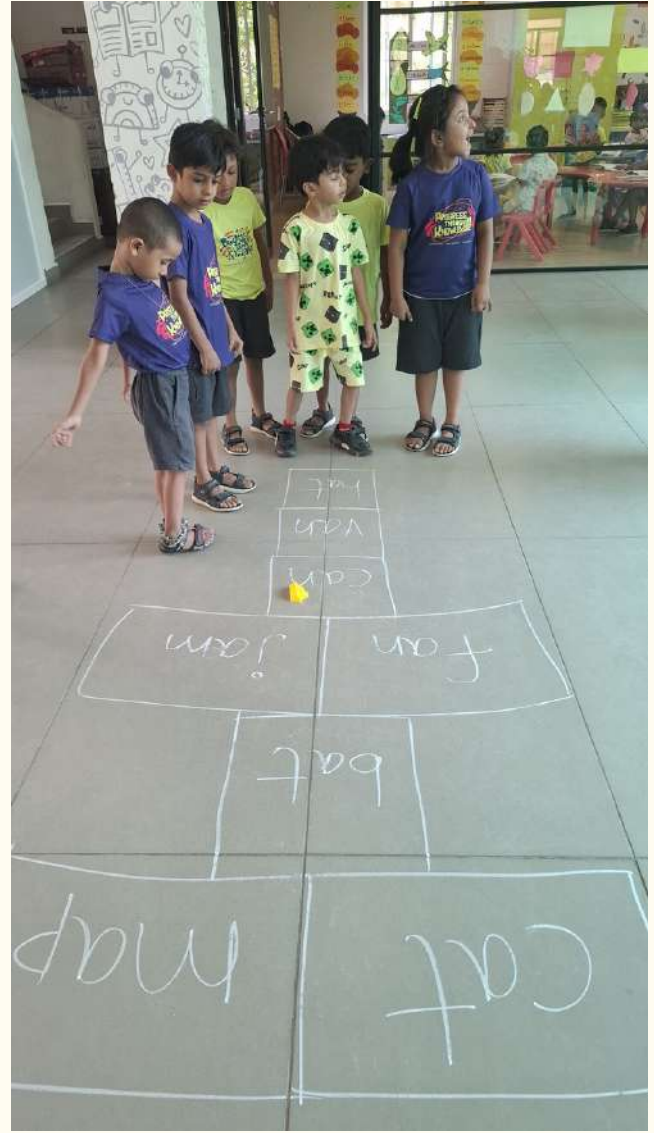
It also strengthens the connection between letters and their sounds and prepares the children for blending sounds together to read simple three-letter (CVC) words

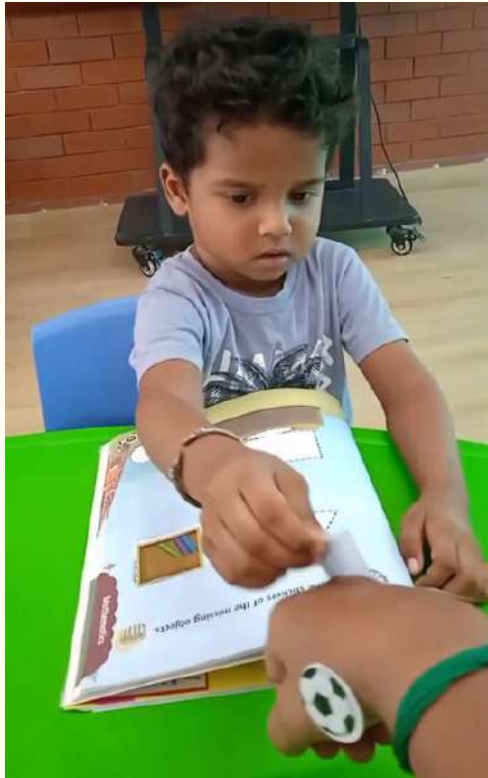

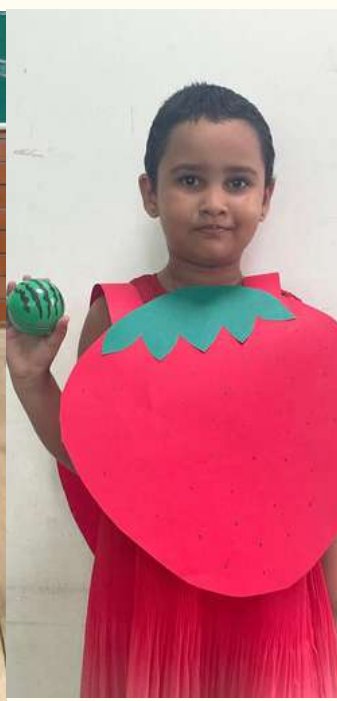

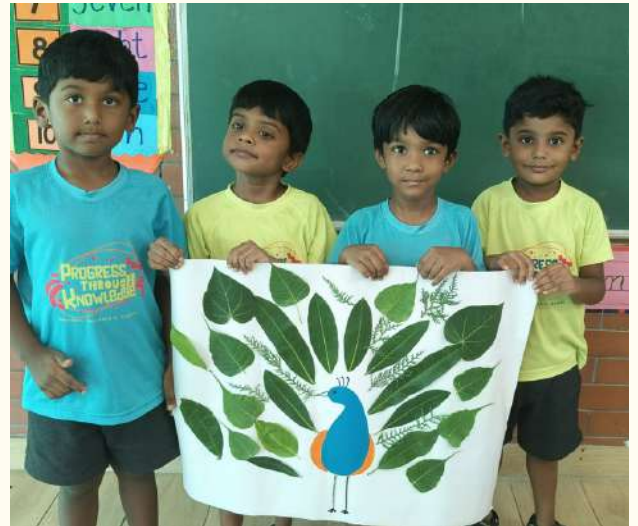


Nature Conservation Day
