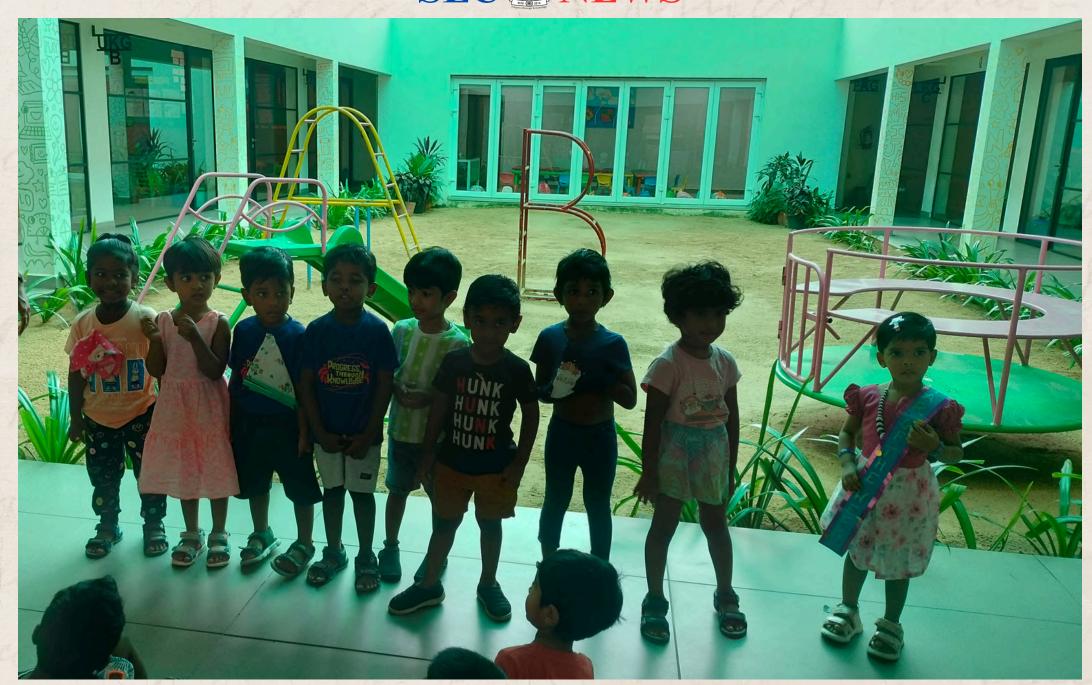




ASSEMBLY

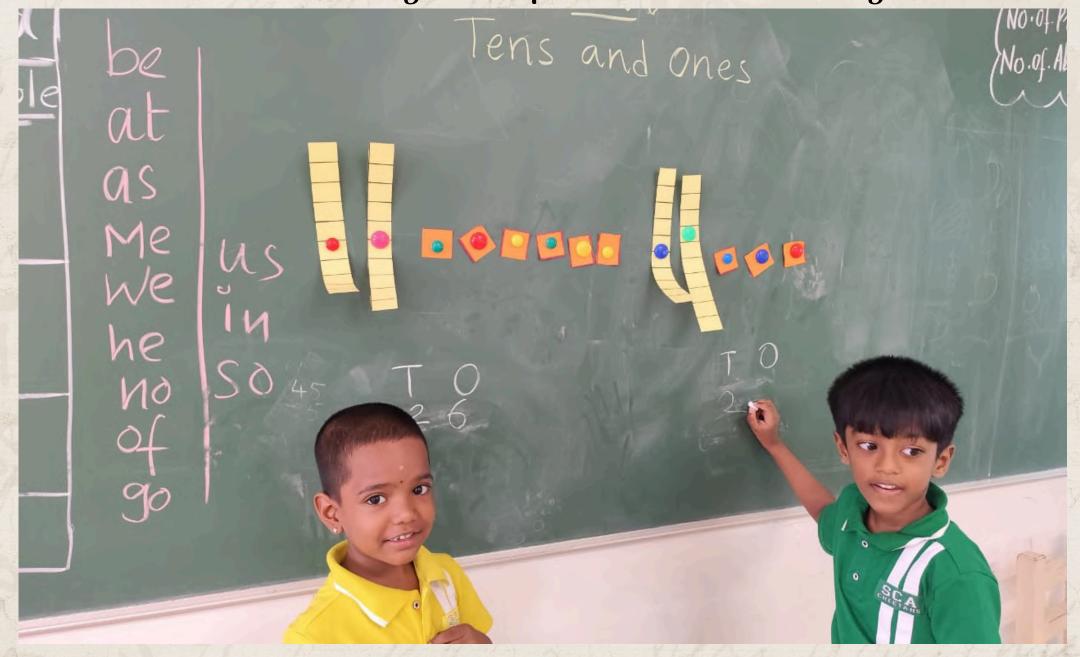




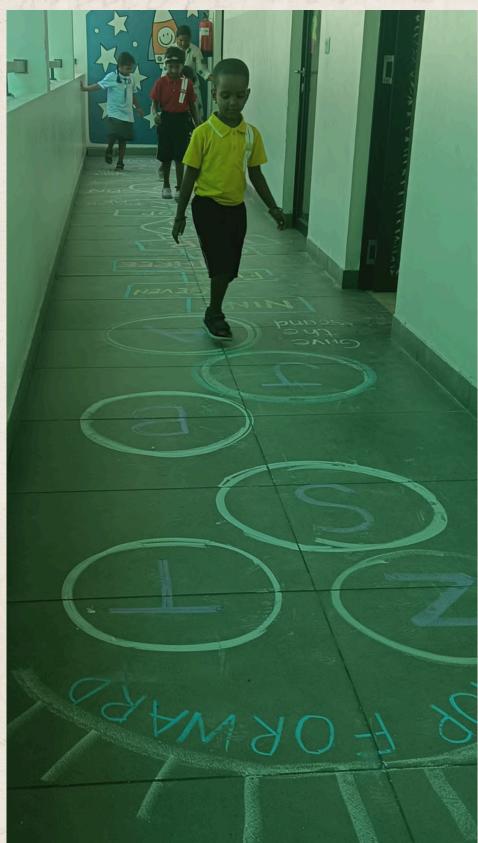


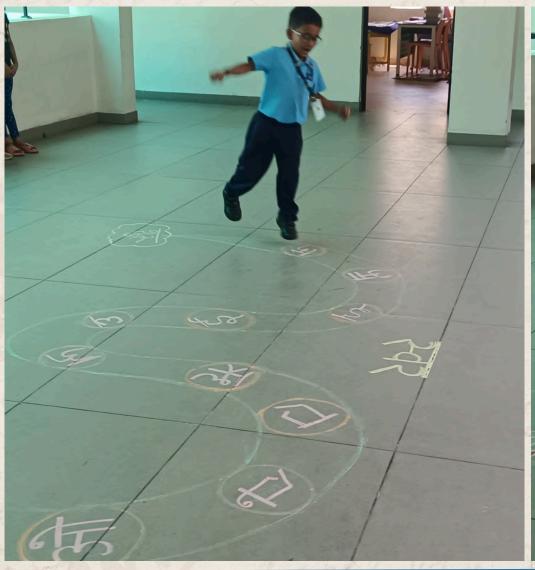
CLASS ACTIVITIES

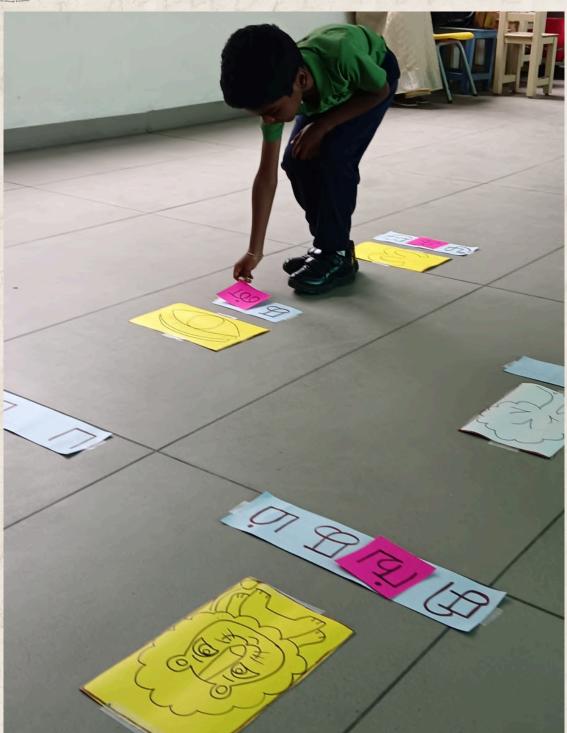


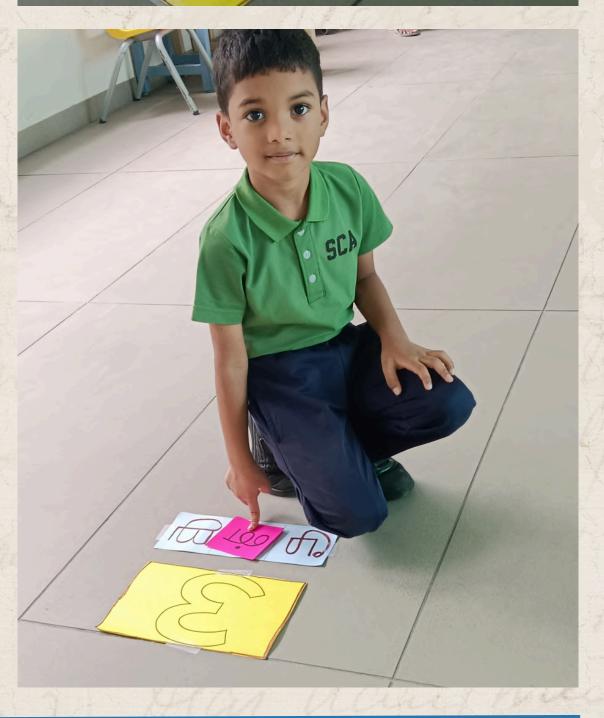






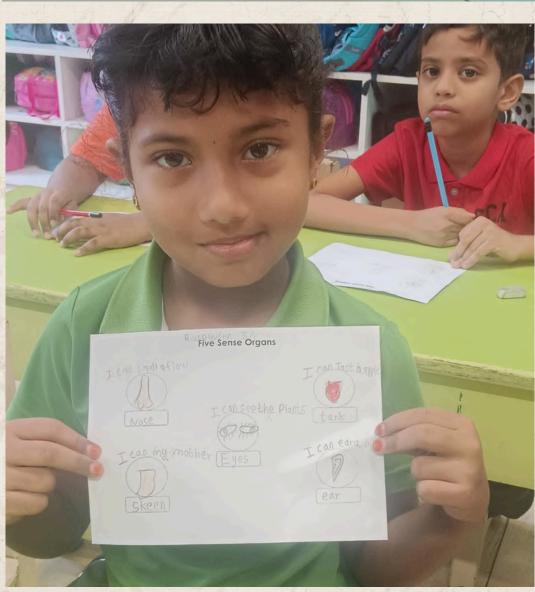


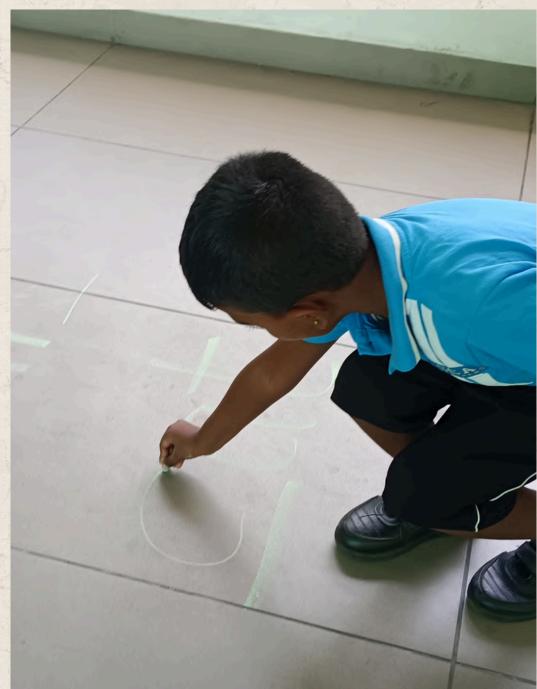


















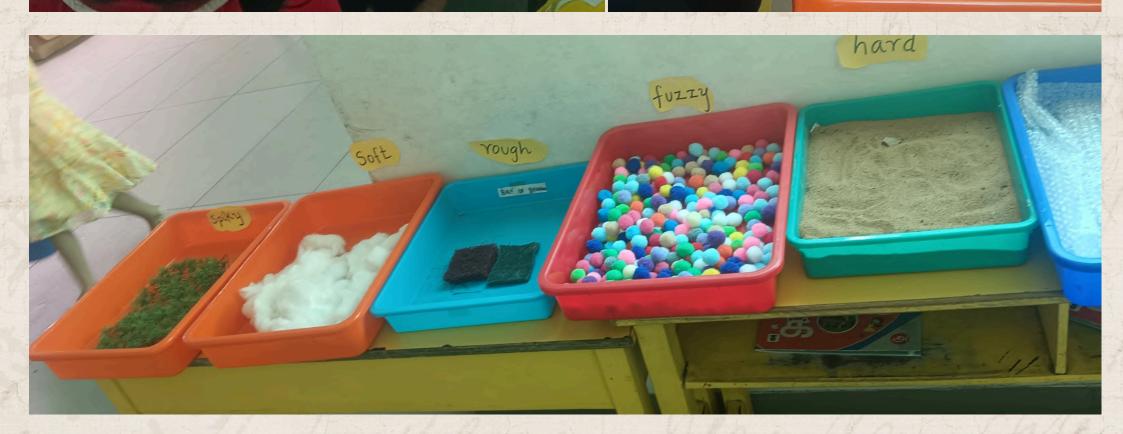










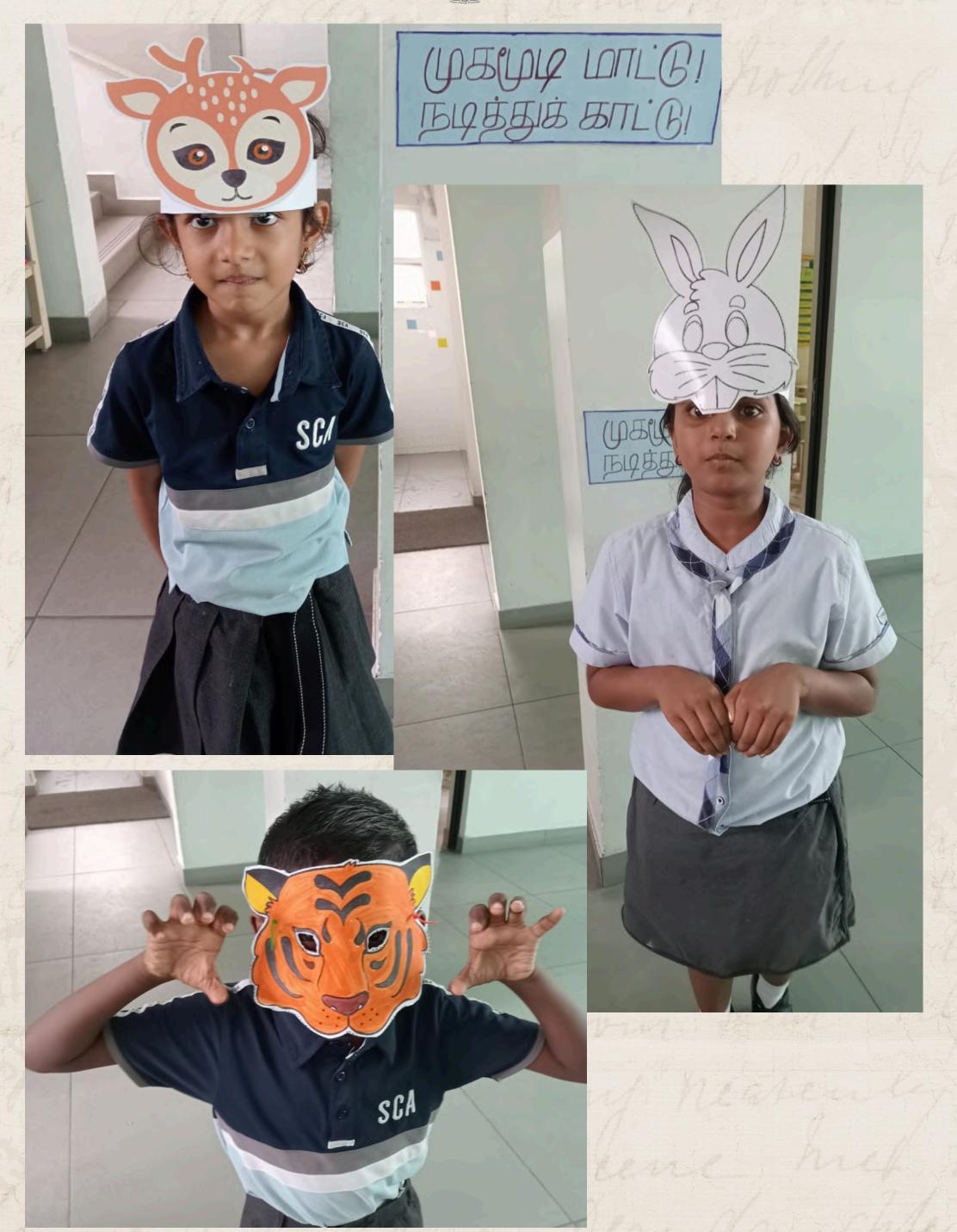




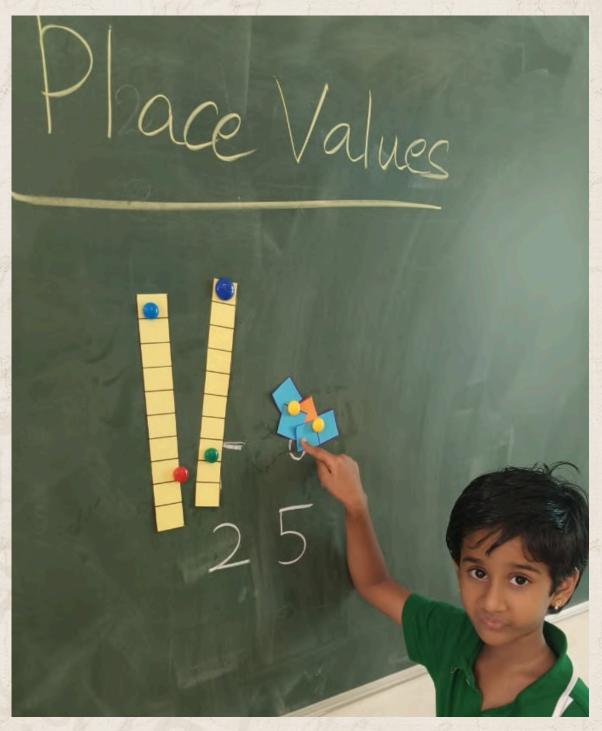


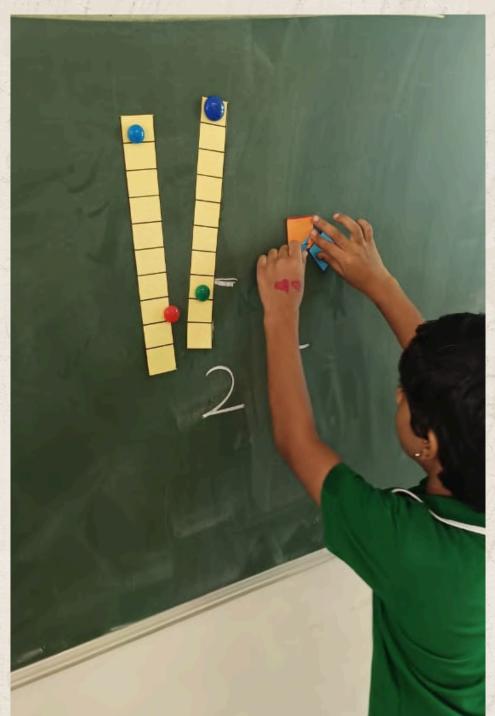






























































VOGA DAV
