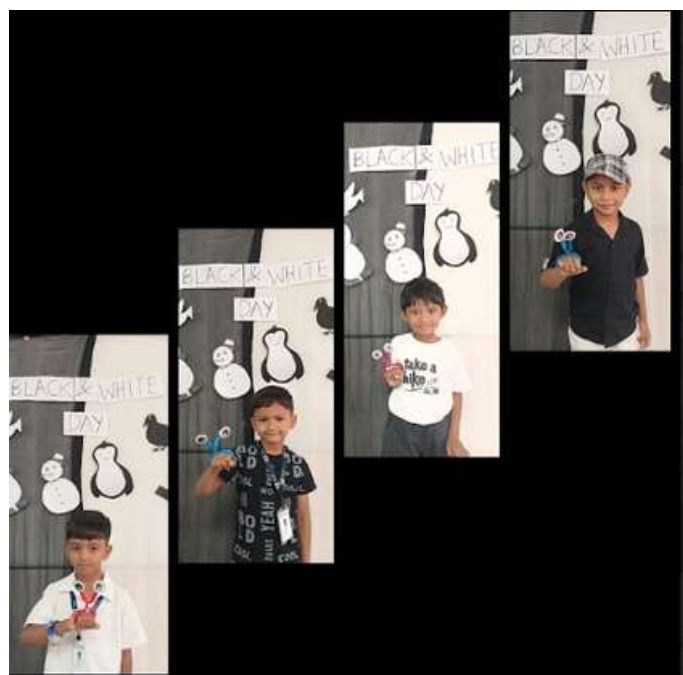


BLACK & WHITE DAY: SEEING THE WORLD WITH CARE!

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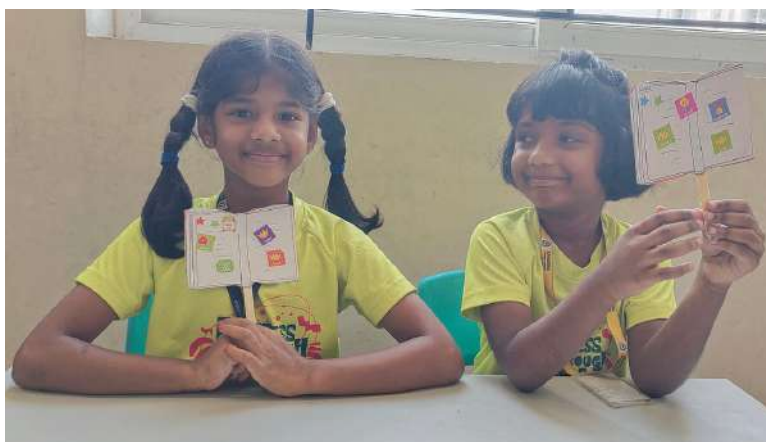
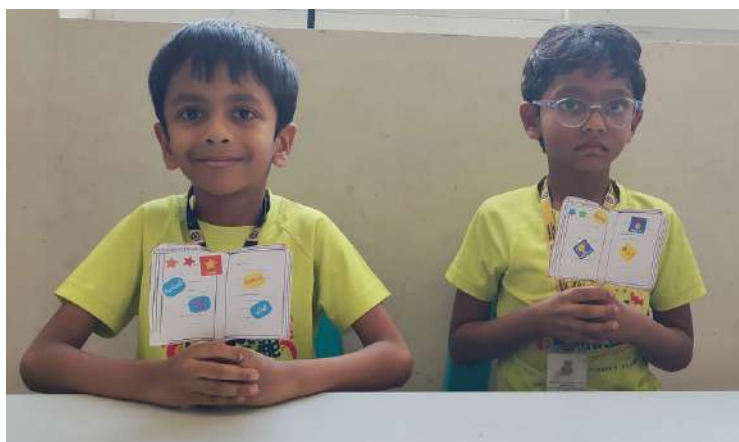
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TIME TO CELEBRATE EACH OTHER

Make a Bird Feeder

Easy 4 Steps for Kids!



1 Get your materials



You need: 2 plastic containers, string, scissors, and birdseed.

2 Make holes
