The day was filled with excitement, learning, and a deep appreciation for nature. Our little environmentalists went home with green hearts and a promise to protect our planet!



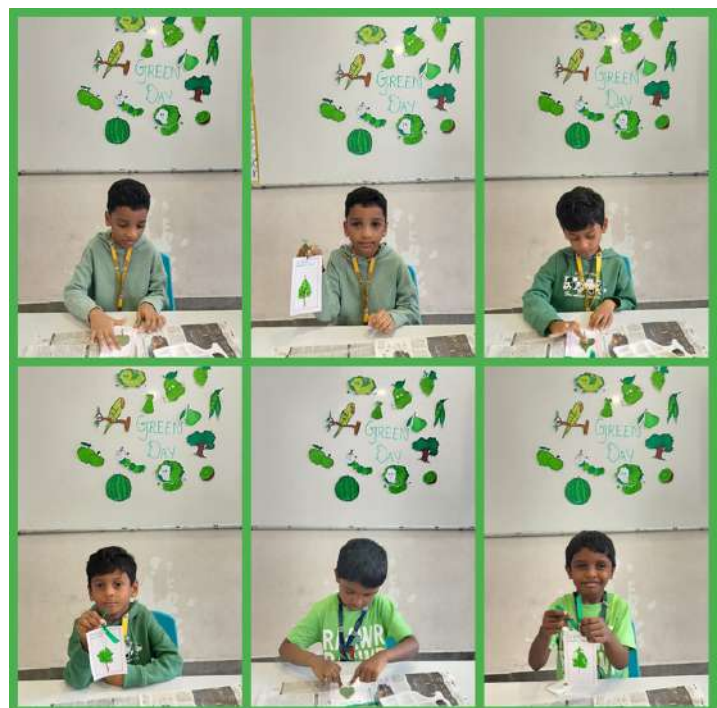

The celebration beautifully reflected the joy of learning, the power of teamwork, and the pride of achieving 100 wonderful days together.



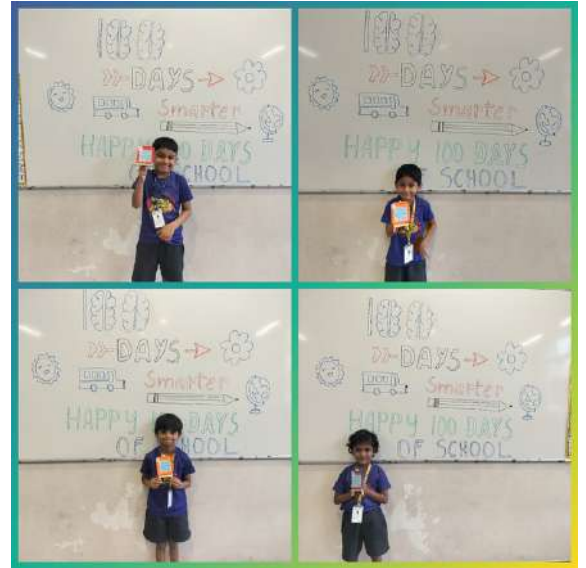
