

They spotted various animals, birds, and plants, developing a deeper connection with the natural world and the importance of conservation.














They were fascinated by the various stamps, parcels, and letters, gaining a new appreciation for the art of correspondence.

Students also learnt about the financial services like banking and insurance offered by the post office.







Students were also felicitated for their achievements through the year.










































