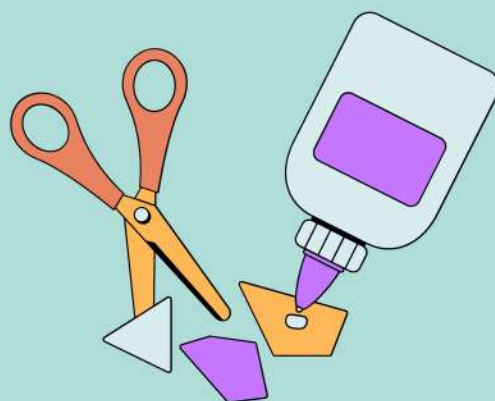
Engaging Activities for Young Ones
