
The main objective of such an approach is to demonstrate the child's knowledge rather than merely discuss it.

During these sessions, students and parents were encouraged to participate in short, hands-on activities such as sorting blocks for numeracy or using tongs for fine motor skill practice, thereby gaining a direct insight into the specific skills being focused upon in the kindergarten classroom.









Through Activity based approach, verbal feedback regarding a child's strengths and areas needing improvement is concretely supported by the actual tasks performed in front of the parents, ensuring that clear, actionable strategies for home reinforcement are communicated, and a true partnership between the home and school is established.
