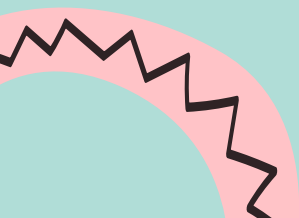
# The Little Entrepreneurs: Shraddha's KG Take Over the Market!
