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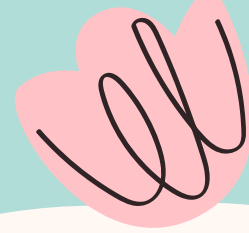
YOGA DAY

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SPARKLE FEST



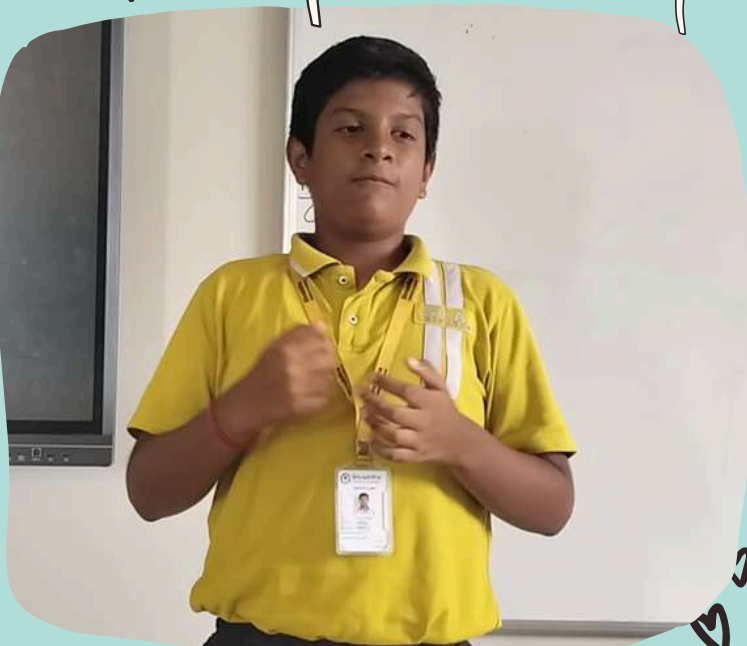

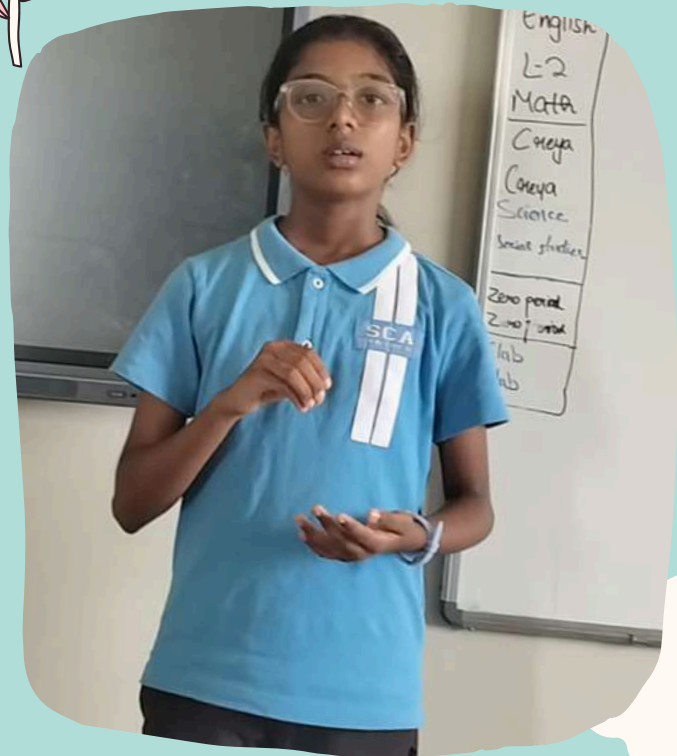
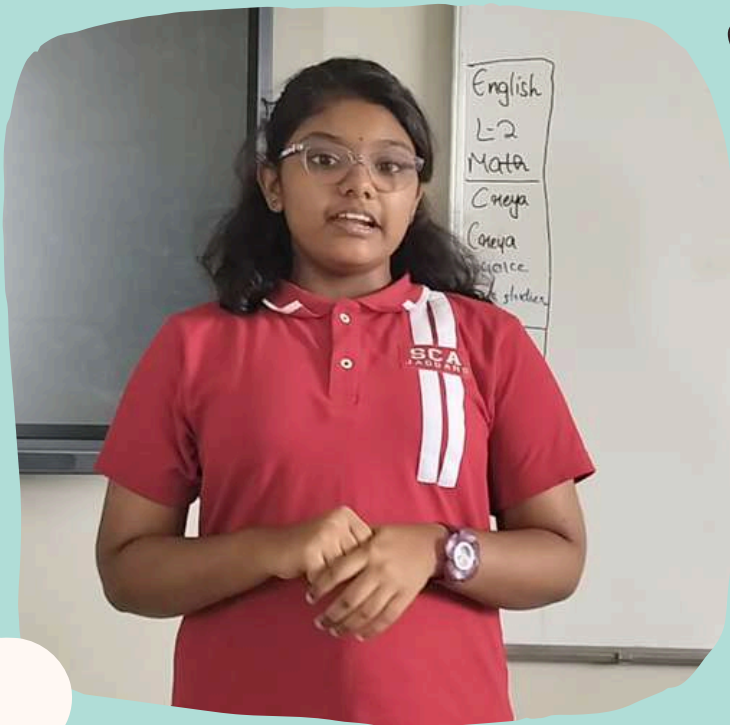
ENGLISH INTERHOUSE COMPETITION



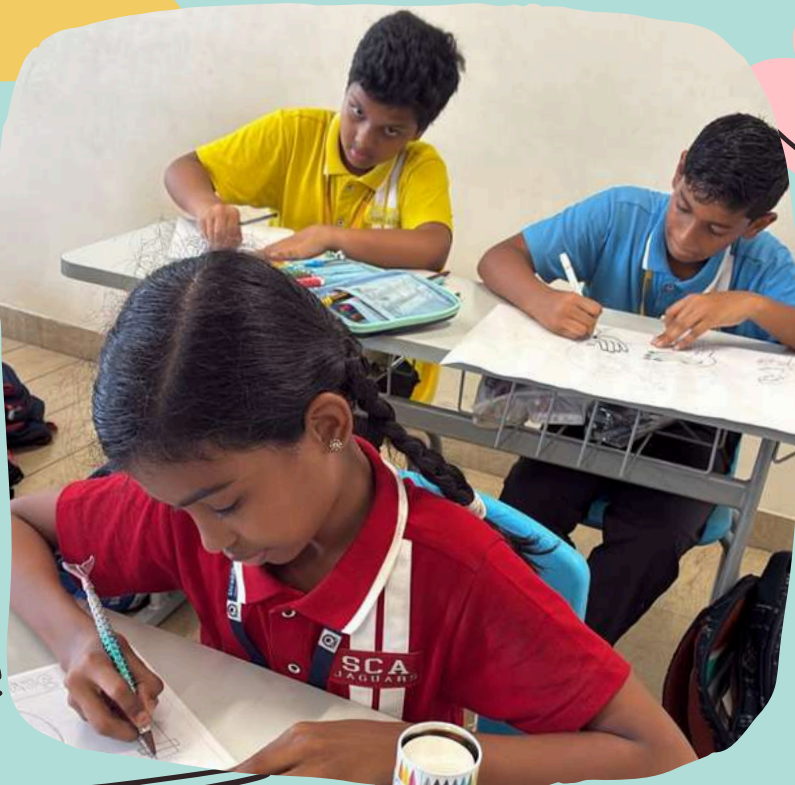

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EXTEMPORE COMPETITION

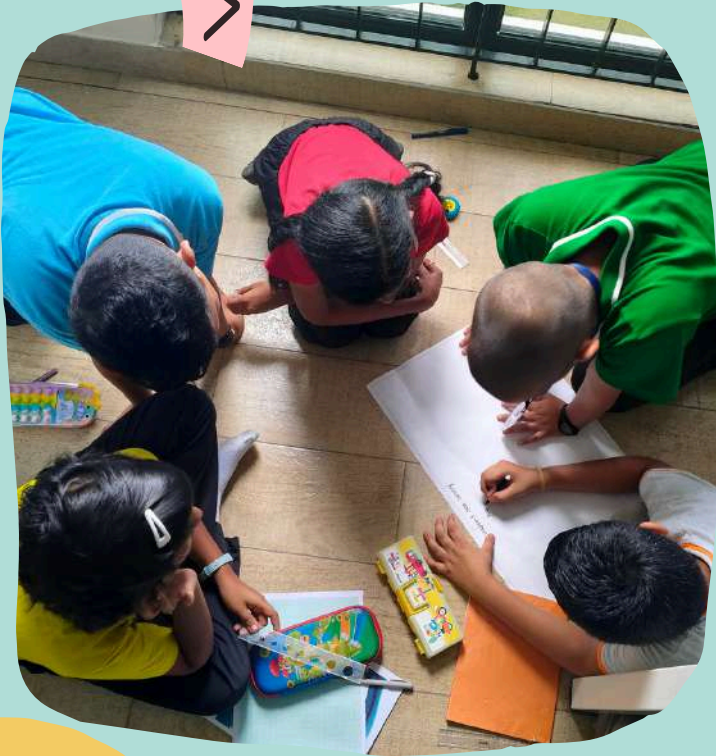
