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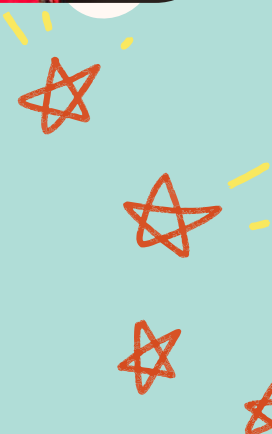


Paint the Town Red! ✨

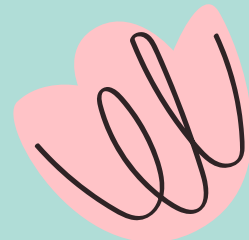

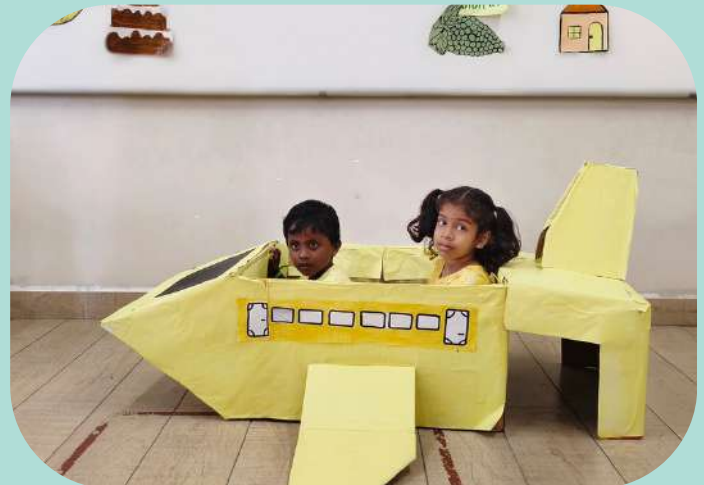
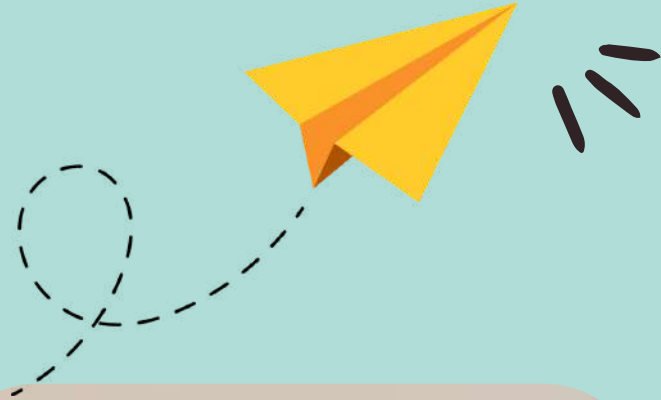


Bright Smiles & Sunshine: Our Yellow Day Celebration!
