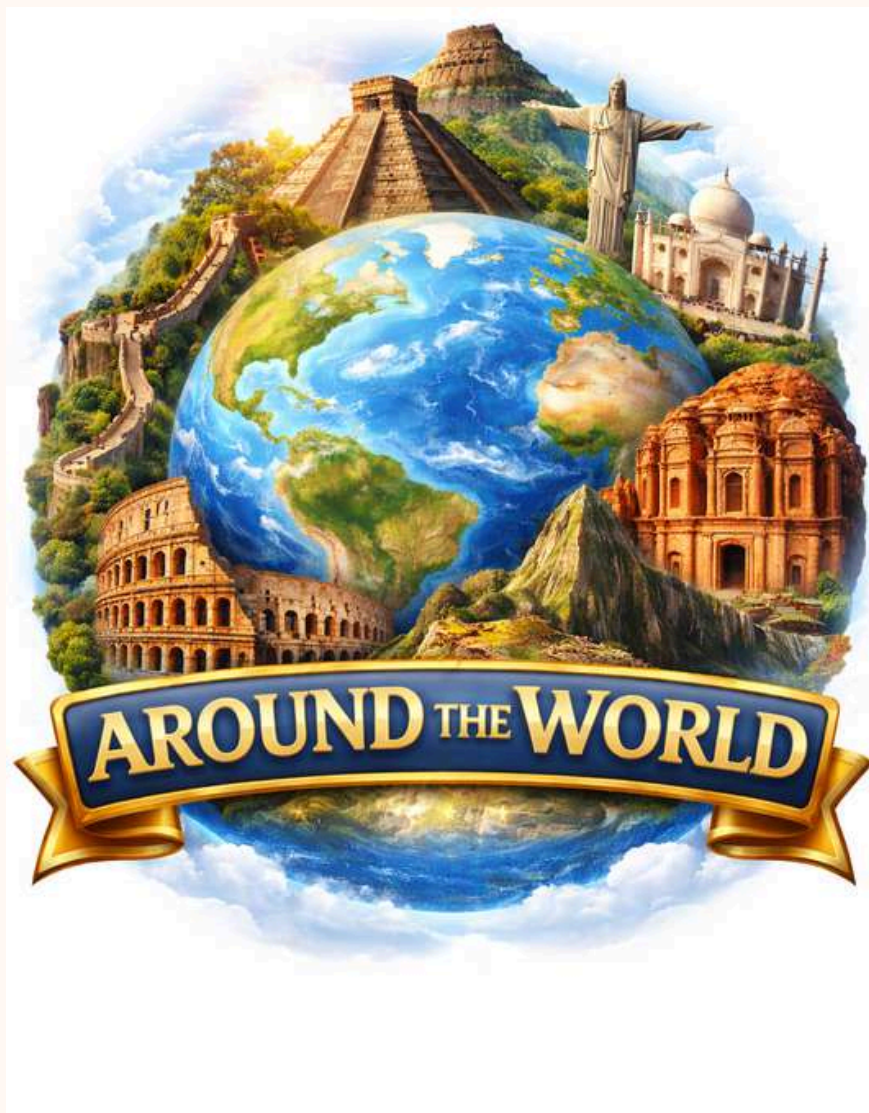

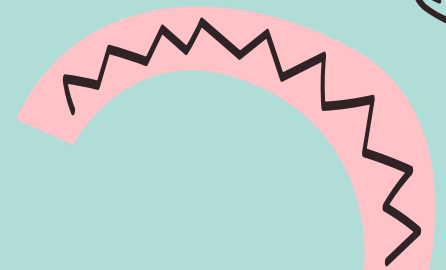
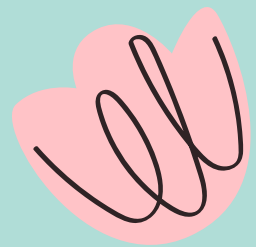
PONGAL CELEBRATION

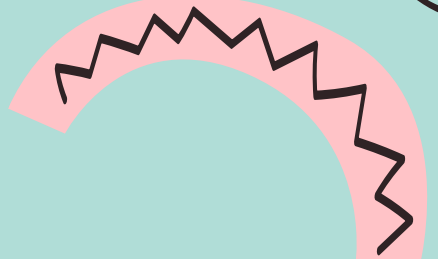
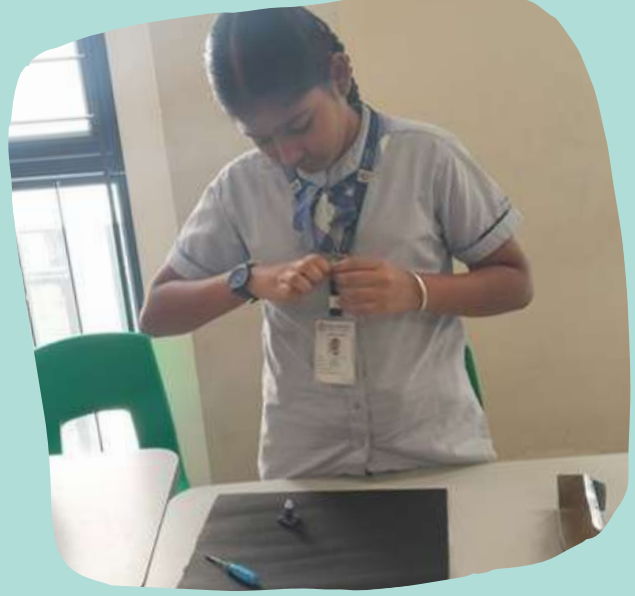
NATIONAL SCIENCE DAY

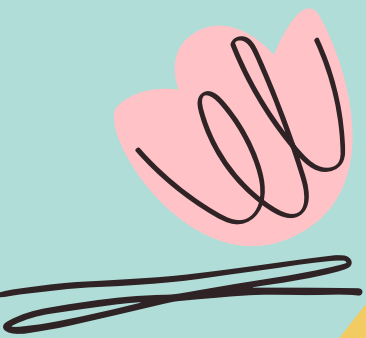
SANCHARAN ANNUAL DAY

KEYBOARD CLUB

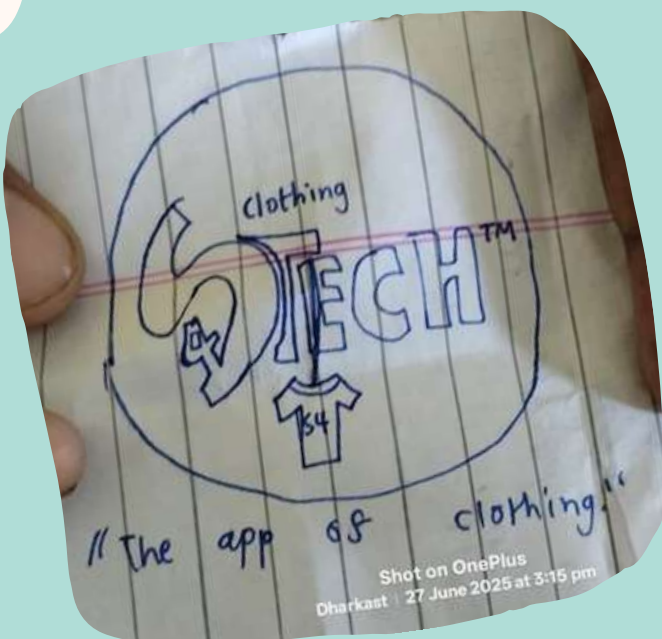
